

Demographic Makeup

- Population is 11,800 individuals in 4,800 households.
- Just over one quarter of households are families with children.
- Forty percent of households are in the top quintile for household income in San Diego. Four percent are in the bottom quintile.
- One of least dense neighborhoods in the city, owing mostly to the large undeveloped canyon areas

- No major shopping centers. **Costco** (original Price Club) is the major retail business. Morena also includes **The Fruit Stand**.
- Santa Fe Street, just east of I-5: Southwest Boulder, Karl Strauss
 Tasting Room and House of Scuba. This area also incudes SDG&E
 Beach Cities Operations Center and Santa Fe Park RV Resort.
- De Anza View is a cluster of professional buildings at the foot of Moraga. Other notable establishments are Salvation Army, Catholic Diocese and Canyon Villas Retirement/Assisted Living Facility. De Anza View is a cluster of professional buildings at the foot of Moraga.
- IsaBella is only major restaurant
- Ethnic food groceries adjacent to the district include Harvest
 Market on Balboa (Middle Eastern and Mexican food products)
 and Mi Tiendita (Mexican food products) on Clairemont Mesa and
 Clairemont Drive.

- Major entries to the park are off Genesee Avenue and Regents Road, includes parking, picnic areas and restroom facilities


Rose Creek Bikeway


